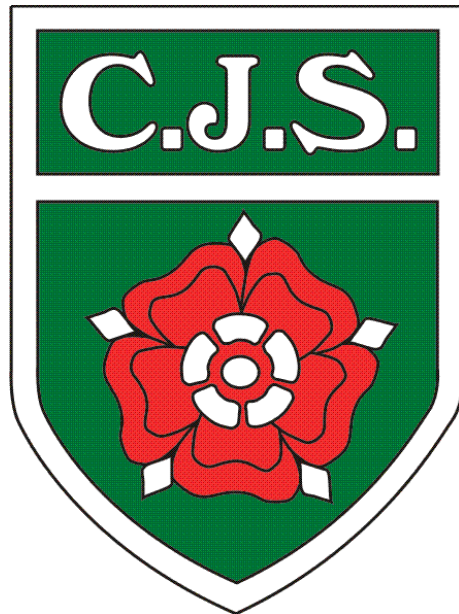

Providing homework once a week which supports learning in school.</p> <p>Updating ParentPay with payment details when necessary</p> <p>Informing parents promptly if accounts are overdrawn</p> <p>Sending out a weekly newsletter with key information and key dates</p> <p>Celebrating good attendance and supporting families where there are problems.</p>	<p>Providing a full school uniform (named) for my child including black school shoes at all times of the year</p> <p>Providing a full, named school PE kit for my child with trainers, to be worn on the appropriate days as scheduled</p> <p>Ensuring my child is appropriately equipped for the anticipated weather conditions</p> <p>Listening to my child read at least 4 times a week and signing their reading record and supporting them to complete their homework</p> <p>Making sure I have paid for my child's school lunch or sent them with a healthy packed lunch</p> <p>Paying outstanding bills promptly</p> <p>Reading the school newsletter every week and making notes of key information</p> <p>Ensuring my child attends school regularly and aim for 96%+ attendance</p>

<p>Be Safe</p>	<p>Giving access to a curriculum which promotes a healthy lifestyle, a physically active curriculum for learning and teach strategies for good mental and emotional health.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - providing fresh drinking water - providing a healthy break-time snack for EYFS and KS1 children - providing healthy lunches <p>Providing PE and physical activity for at least half an hour every day and providing swimming lessons for Year 4 pupils</p> <p>Ensuring that adults are available for children to speak to about their concerns</p> <p>Using Restorative Justice, talk time and consequences to support conflict resolution</p> <p>Responding to concerns raised by parents/carers</p> <p>Ensuring school starts and ends promptly and children are released safely</p> <p>Monitoring car parking and report unsafe vehicles</p> <p>Taking account of any information given to support children in school</p> <p>Providing a safe school environment</p>	<p>Promoting healthy life choices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sending in only water as a drink during the day - sending fruit or healthy snack in to school for KS2 children - packing a healthy lunch which does not include chocolate or sweets <p>Ensuring my child takes part in PE and swimming sessions</p> <p>Promoting positive behaviour which involves seeking the help of an adult when needed</p> <p>Supporting the school's behaviour policy and non-violent means of solving problems and conflicts</p> <p>Contacting school if I have concerns about another child's behaviour</p> <p>Ensuring my child arrives and is collected on time</p> <p>Parking safely and legally</p> <p>Informing the school of any problems likely to affect my child</p> <p>Providing a safe home environment</p>
