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Punctuality

We're sure you'll appreciate the need to ensure that children are at school on time every day. Every minute late to school is lost learning time.

We were rather disappointed when we recently analysed the school's punctuality data from the start of the school year. Would you believe that since the beginning of this school year, 67 different pupils have arrived at school after the gates shut at 8.50am on a total of 156 occasions. This has amounted to 1885 minutes of lost learning. Whilst some of these late arrivals are unavoidable due to appointments the rest are just down to late arrivals.

We would like to remind parents that the school gates are open between **8.35am** and **8.50am** and we expect all but a minority of pupils (for whom special arrangements will have been agreed with the school) to arrive between these times.
