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## Welcome/Welcome Back

We would like to welcome all our new pupils who have all settled in very well to their new school and routine. A big welcome back to all our old pupils too. It has been lovely to see all your smiley faces (new and familiar) around the building and hear the buzz that only fills the school when the children are here.

# End of School Day - IMPORTANT

Please remember that, as of Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September, **ALL** pupils will be leaving at 3.20pm.

We are also removing the one-way system for parents at the end of the school day. Parents will **arrive through the top gates** <u>and</u> **exit through the top gates**. The bottom gates will be for Year 5 and Year 6 pupils who have permission to walk home. This should help remove the bottle-neck at the bottom gates and should ensure that there is a safe separation between the parents and the teacher's groups of children (3)

We respectfully ask parents to wait behind the yellow netball court line (where the benches are) and to wait for their child to come to them before exiting through the top gates.

If you need to speak to the class teacher at the end of the day, please wait until they have safely dismissed all of their class before approaching them.

We ask that you are patient with us dismissing your children, we need to ensure that every child leaves with the correct adult and the playground will be even busier than normal from Monday.

We would strongly encourage only one parent to collect children at the end of the school day, in order to reduce the number of people on the playground as much as possible.

### <u>ParentPay</u>

Thank you to all those parents who have topped up their accounts to ensure they are in credit. Please can we ask all parents whose child/ren have school dinners ensure their accounts are in credit.

Please can anyone with an outstanding debt clear it. We will have to stop children having dinners if their accounts are in debt. There is a large amount of money outstanding for dinners and this affects the level of service we can offer ALL children. If you are experiencing difficulties clearing a debt please call the office to discuss setting up a payment plan.

To our new Year 3 parents, please remember to activate your school account. This is essential even if you have an account from the Zone or a previous school.

The Derbyshire Immunisation Team have confirmed that they will be coming into school on 6th December to administer flu vaccines. Below is the letter they have asked us to pass on to our parents:

Dear Parents/Carers

For the school year starting September 2021 we will be continuing with the e-consent for the Flu Programme. This year we will be offering the Nasal Flu vaccination to children in **Reception**, **Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6**.

https://www.derbyshireandcityimms.co.uk/Forms/ Flu to complete the consent form. The option to consent or decline the vaccination is at the end of the questionnaire so please complete even if you do not want your child to have the vaccination.

If you wish to decline the Flu spray due to the porcine element we are now able to offer an alternative injectable Flu vaccine that does not contain porcine. Please complete the consent form as a decline due to vaccine ingredients and we will then contact you to arrange vaccination. For more information please contact the team as below.
