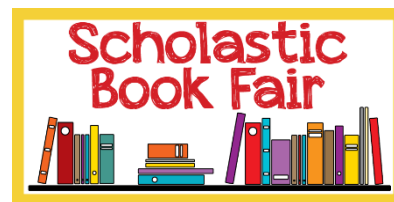
Thank you to the majority of our parents who do follow this procedure.
