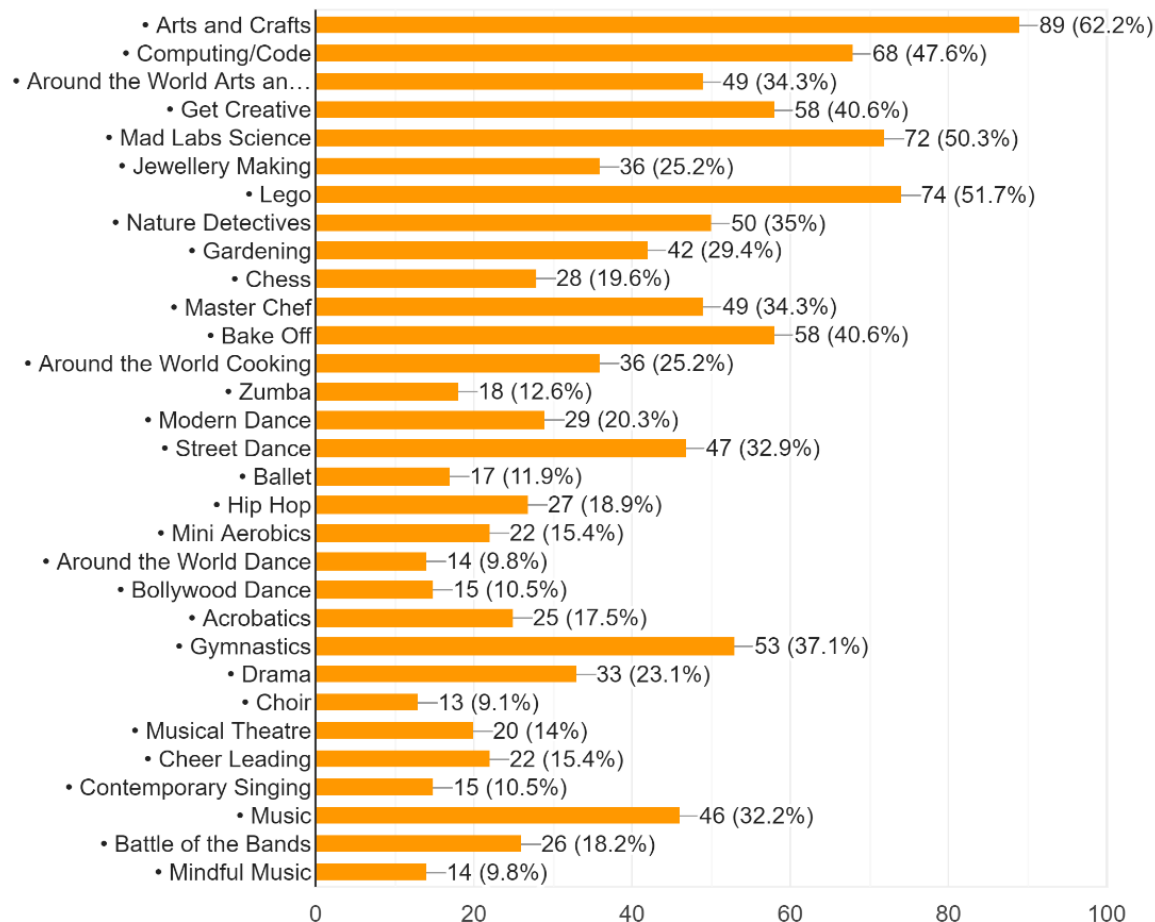
After School Clubs for September
