

Mobile Phones



At Chellaston Junior School, **we do not normally allow pupils to bring their phones to school.**

There are very rare circumstances in which pupils of a primary school age would need to have a mobile phone. On school days, this might be when they are:

- Travelling to school by themselves
- Young carers who need to be contactable

Pupils who do bring phones to school **must** hand them in on a daily basis to be stored either in the school office or the lock box in the class room. Pupils are responsible for collecting their phone at the end of the school day.

Pupils **must not** bring their mobile phone into school and disguise the fact by storing them in their school bag or a pocket. They are **not allowed to use or access their phone during the school day** and they **must not take mobile phones on residential visits or on school day trips.**

Parents must inform the school office if they are giving permission for their child to bring their phone to school so that Scholarpack can be updated accordingly.

We do not expect any children in Years 3 or 4 to bring mobile phones to school.
